

Yukon Children's Dental Program Referrals to dentists in private practice

The Yukon Children's Dental Program (YCDP) can refer children to dentists in private practice for preventive and restorative services which are normally provided by a dental therapist. The children must be enrolled in YCDP and have medical conditions or present patient management considerations. Only services identified by the dental therapist and described on the referral form will be covered by the YCDP; please note that the referral expires six months from the date of issue.

Yukon Children's Dental Program will reimburse dentists for services requested on referral according to the fees listed in the Yukon Dental Association fee guide.

The table below is a comprehensive listing of services which will be covered by YCDP upon referral by a dental therapist.

Restorative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ amalgam (primary/permanent) ◆ composite resin: anterior and posterior teeth. ◆ stainless steel crowns on primary posterior teeth. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ stainless steel crowns on permanent teeth.
Endodontics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ vital pulpotomies on primary teeth. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ vital pulpotomies on permanent teeth. ◆ root canals on permanent teeth. ◆ non-vital pulpotomies
Sedation		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ sedation of <i>any</i> kind.
Accidents to Teeth		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ not covered. ◆ should not be referred either at time of accident or if problems arise later. ◆ parents have option to purchase school insurance.
